WORK HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY

Our Health and Safety culture will be founded on:

- Accountability of everyone that works with Koonenberry Gold to ensure that the workplace and practices comply with statutory requirements, safe work practices and healthy industry practices as a minimum standard with the intent of preventing injury and accidents;
- Identifying and implementing a Safety Management System across the business and ensuring personnel, contractors and other stakeholders are aware and, where required, trained accordingly;
- Regular assessment of the Safety Management System will ensure that it complies with its commitments and conditions and that all Health and Safety objectives and targets are being met.
